Forthcoming Meetings: MARCH AND APRIL

Sugar Collection - A Repeat Notice

For those who are new to the scheme you bring your own container to the beeshed and empty out 10kg quantities into your own receptacles and leave empty buckets on the decking for our sugar collectors to then refill. **Only collect when you are notified** as we work down the list of names submitted. £2 per 10kgs of sugar. Money to be placed in the nearby honesty box please.
